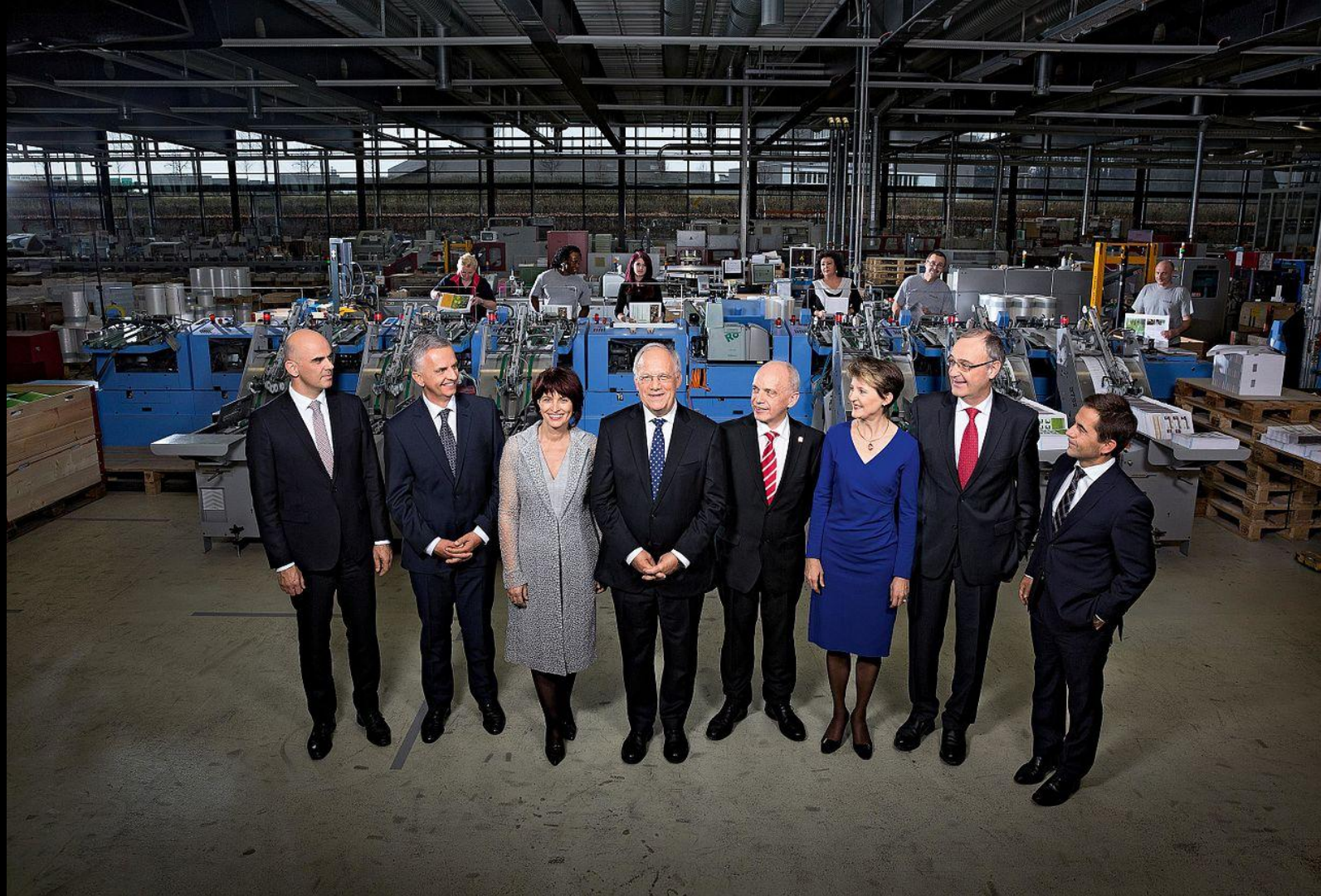

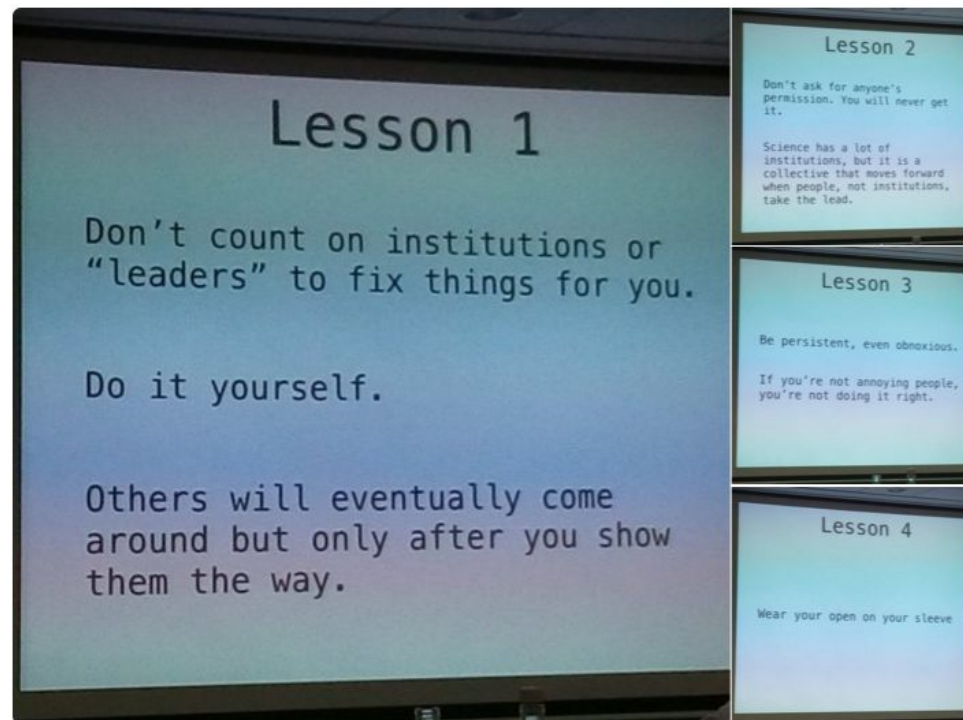

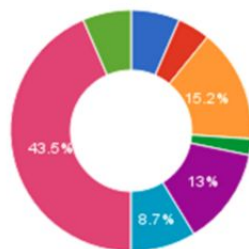

Demographic breakdown of attendees

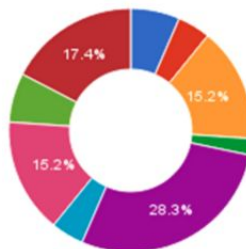
